The three-day train-the-trainer activity co-organized for the first time by INTERPOL's Counterfeit Currency and Security Documents (CCSD) branch and IDEMIA involved border control and immigration officers, document experts and forensic document examiners.

The training was the occasion to exchange views with INTERPOL on the security features to ensure the authenticity and integrity of the identity documents.
